

Lunches and Snacks:

Students should bring a lunch plus two snacks each day.

Field Trips:

Students participate in field trips during Intersession at no additional charge. Students who sign up for half days will stay in a small, supervised group doing activities on site unless parents make arrangements with the manager to allow their child to attend the field trip.

To Register:

Complete the registration form and return it to the Community Education office with the appropriate fees and full payment for the **first intersession program**. For example if you are sending one child to the Fall program you must send \$420 if you are not currently enrolled in before or after school (\$30 registration fee and \$130 for each week) or \$390 if currently enrolled in programs.

Payments for additional intersessions must be received by the printed deadline for each program.

Please note that you will not be contacted for payment. If payment is not received, registration will be invalid. Please be sure to fill out each section completely to avoid delays in processing your program choices. We cannot accept registration from families with overdue Community Education accounts.



Register Early!

Registrations are accepted on a space available basis – first come, first served. Payments must be made in full by printed deadlines in order to participate in the intersession program. No payments will be accepted after 5:00 pm on the printed deadline date, either by mail or in person.
