Jill Boliek holds M.M. and B.M. degrees in music education from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Jill is in her twentieth year of teaching. The past 19 years having been at Riverside High School in Durham. She is the cultural arts department chair and graduation coordinator for her school as well as the district lead event coordinator for high school chorus. She is a member of NAfME, NCMEA and ACDA. Jill was the middle school vocal clinician for Durham Public Schools' An Evening of Entertainment in 2014 and 2016 as well as the middle school vocal clinician for the Moore County All-County Chorus in 2016. Each year her students participate in their district-level music performance adjudication and have consistently earned superior and excellent ratings in performance and sight-singing. Jill has taken students to choral competitions in Atlanta, New York City, Chicago, the Bahamas, Boston, San Francisco, Nashville and Washington, D.C. as well as concert tours in Germany, Austria, and the Czech Republic. In addition to teaching, Jill is the accompanist for Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church in Raleigh, NC. She lives in Durham, NC with her husband, Mark, their daughter, Joey, and their Scottish Terrier, Fergus.

# High School Choreographer

Freddie-Lee Heath brings a rich career as a dancer, teacher and choreographer for 40 years having nearly 150 productions to his credit. Heath holds a BS in Dance Education from East Carolina University along with a Master's in School Administration from North Carolina State University. He has many awards including National Dance Educator of the Year (twice), Raleigh Medal of Arts by the City of Raleigh, Order of the Long Leaf Pine by the state of NC, Wake County Public Schools Hall of Fame for Arts. Amy Brock Davis is the lead teacher for Durham Public Schools' Middle School Chorus section and the Evening to Shine Middle School Clinician for 2023. Mrs. Davis is the co-director of Choral Activities at Durham School of the Arts and the conductor for the Mosaic Singers of the Raleigh Youth Choir. She was the conductor for the Girls Chorale of the Capital City Girls Choir at Meredith College from 2006-2021. A 1992 Meredith College graduate with a Bachelor of Arts in Music, she received her Master of Music in Choral Directing from Appalachian State University in 1995. Mrs. Davis is a National Board Certified Teacher specializing in early adolescence through young adulthood choral music. Her choirs have sung in Atlanta, West Virginia, New York, Florida, Munich, Vienna, Venice, Florence, Rome, and London. Mrs. Davis was the recipient of the 2017 Richard Keasler NC Middle School Choral Teacher of the Year award which was presented by the North Carolina Music Educators Association. She is the choral director and organist at Glendale Heights United Methodist Church. Mrs. Davis lives in Durham with her husband, Ken, and daughter, Emily.

# Middle School Choreographer

Trey Fletcher is a dynamic choreographer and seasoned dance performer whose passion for movement has spanned over 15 years. Trey's journey into the world of dance began as a sanctuary for his mental well-being, evolving into a remarkable career marked by dedication and artistic excellence. Since 2019, Trey has been teaching across the country.

A proud alum of Durham Public Schools, Trey attended Durham School of the Arts for high school and Carrington Middle School. An active member of the American Choral Directors Association and the American Orff-Schulwerk Association, Dena has been a quest conductor for All-State Honor Choirs in Mississippi, Florida and Tennessee as well as District All-County Choirs in North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida and Alabama. She has presented workshops for Orff Schulwerk chapters throughout the US and at National AOSA Professional Development Conferences. Dena currently teaches Level II Orff Schulwerk at the University of Memphis each summer. She received B.A. degrees in Music Education and Vocal Performance from the University of Connecticut, a Master of Music from the University of Minnesota and holds Level III and Master Level Orff Schulwerk Certifications from the University of Nevada-Las Vegas and the University of Memphis, respectively.
