- Monday, July 31, is the Middle College High School Staff Retreat. All staff will have limited availability on this date.

- Wednesday, August 2, is a teacher's workday.
- Thursday, August 3, is the first day of school for all students. All students must attend the
 opening-of-school assembly in order to become officially enrolled in PowerSchool for
 Middle College High School. Please note that the <u>First Day of School Assembly Schedule</u>
 is different from the <u>Regular Bell Schedule</u>.
 - High School schedules were provided to new students during MavCon.
 - All returning students and anyone who did not attend MavCon will receive their schedules at the opening assembly.
 - Our open campus policy will begin following the opening assembly and students who do not have any high school classes are permitted to leave once the assembly is over. Students with high school classes are permitted to leave campus for lunch.
- Friday, August 4, MCHS will run on a <u>regular bell schedule</u>. There will not be a Town Hall scheduled for August 4.
- Students who took summer school classes may begin returning summer school textbooks on August 3 and August 4, beginning at 8:45 a.m. Please remind students that they must turn in their summer textbooks before they will be issued textbooks for the fall.
