What to do if your student is sick/symptomatic, tests positive or is identified as a close contact for Covid-19:

- **Step 1:** Notify the principal immediately (**Positive, Symptomatic, or Close Contact**)
- **Step 2:** Fill out the [DTCC Contact Tracing Form](#) (*If you are positive or symptomatic only!*)
 - **Update:** Quarantine/Campus restriction is not required for close contacts. You may come to campus but must wear a mask 100% of the time for 10 days. If you become symptomatic within those 10 days, please start back at Step 1.
- **Step 3:** Stay home and wait to be contacted by the DTCC Covid response team. They will provide the student with next steps. (Please note that due to the number of cases, this could take 24-48 hours)
- **Step 4:** Notify all teachers and instructors that you have activated the Covid-19 process.
- **Step 5:** Provide BOTH the MCHS principal AND the DTCC Covid-19 team with all positive or negative test results.
