







# Dramatic Arts Week of November 16<sup>th</sup> Activities

<p><b>KINDERGARTEN</b></p> <p>What is there to learn from the characters behavior in this week's story?</p> <p><b>Choose KINDNESS.</b></p>  <p>Try doing <b>1</b> act of kindness for someone today.</p>		<p><b>FIRST</b></p> <p>In this week's story, the main characters learned quite a bit about independence. Take some time to do an independent activity of <b>your choice</b>. Enjoy!</p> 
	<p><b>SECOND</b></p> <p>Write about your own legendary character. Remember a story becomes a legend by having so much information added to it over time. Do not forget to exaggerate!</p> <p><b>LEGENDS</b></p>	<p><b>THIRD</b></p> <p>As time passes, especially if a story is not written down, many details of the original story may change. Share a story you know from memory with someone. The story could be one of personal experience or one you heard from a love one.</p>
