

Growing Together: Estimated Impact on LMMS (2025-26)

- 1) Incoming spaces available for 6th grade at LMMS

Total LMMS Seats Available: 105

- 2) The **neighborhood zones** of two schools (Lakewood Elem/Morehead Elem) get in automatically and must **OPT OUT** if they do not wish to attend LMMS.

- 3) Given the Dual Language Immersion Program at Lakewood Elementary and the fact that some families may determine that a Montessori structure is not for them, DPS estimates the following breakdown is most likely for LMMS’s attendance zone seats:

Estimated Attendance Zone Students: 55-60		
Lakewood Elementary Attendance Zone (Estimated that 35-40 graduating 5 th graders will attend LMMS)	New Morehead Elementary Attendance Zone (Estimated that 18-20 of graduating 5 th graders will attend LMMS)	This would leave an estimated <u>45-50 magnet seats available</u>

- 4) Students at a Montessori Elementary school would be given priority for the available magnet seats. Therefore, rising sixth graders at **Watts, Morehead** (those that attend Morehead but are not in the attendance zone), and eventually **Little River** would be given priority. We anticipate that there will be more students from Montessori Elementary Schools than available lottery seats, meaning that all lottery seats will be filled by Montessori Elementary students.

Estimated Lottery Seats Available: 45-50
