Carpool is always challenging, especially at the beginning of the year. Once everyone gets used to the flow of traffic, things tend to run smoother. We will not be running a walkup process to pick kids up afterschool at this time and therefore there will be more cars in the carpool loop. I am asking all of our parents to please practice patience as our carpool dismissal tends to be more time consuming than our morning drop off procedure. It is important that we have kids in the right location to ensure they are ready to be picked up. We have learned a few things and are hoping some of the new changes being implemented will eliminate “carpool stress” and speed up the process a little to avoid as much backup on Barbee Rd as possible. Please note the following changes below...

- ❖ *There will be no “Temperature Check” protocols during morning arrival.*
- ❖ *Students will be dropped off and picked up at two locations: the bus lot and the gym entrance.*
- ❖ *K-1 Students and their siblings (in grades 2-5) will be dropped off and picked up in the bus lot.*
- ❖ *Grades 2-5 students with no siblings will be dropped off and picked up at the gym entrance.*
- ❖ *Bus students will enter the building via the bus lot entrance as normal.*
- ❖ *Breakfast will be available at each of the entrances for convenience and students will proceed to class and eat breakfast in their rooms.*
- ❖ *Trash Cans will be available in the hallways for students to dispose of their trash before school begins.*
- ❖ *Also...students will eat lunch in their classrooms or outside until further guidance is provided by the district regarding social distancing restrictions and protocols.*
- ❖ *Masks are required to be worn by every student and staff member attending Pearsonstown at all times, unless designated as a “mask-less break time”. These and other social distancing*
