Dear Students and Parents,

Exams at Hillside High School will occur from June 5, 2017 thru June 8, 2017 with all students taking one exam per day. Make up exams will be held on June 9, 2017.

Please be aware of the guidelines for final exams and prepare accordingly:

- Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period and remain the entire period to receive credit for the exam. Please do not make appointments between **9:00 am and 1:00 pm**. We **will not** call into classrooms during exams for any reason.
- All cell phones must be turned **off and put away** during the exam period for all standardized testing.
- Students, please plan to be present on the exam days to avoid having to make-up any final exams.
- In all courses, the final exam will count **20%** of the student's final grade.
- High school students may be exempt from their **non-EOC, non-VoCATS, & non-NC State final exams** if they meet one of the following conditions:
 - Have an "A" average and no more than **three** absences.
 - Have a "B" average and no more than **two** absences.

Any absences (lawful or unlawful) count toward the limit for exam exemption except school sponsored field trips, school approved activities and religious holidays.

- Students who are exempt from an exam may elect to take the exam. The grade will count only if it improves the student's overall grade.
