Technology Return Information

Chromebooks, chargers, and hot spots will be collected on the following dates from **9:00 am - 3:00 pm.**

Please Note:

8th Graders should plan on returning their Chromebooks on June 4, the last day of school. 8th graders must return their Chromebooks and any other tech provided before they can be issued a new computer when they start high school.

- Drop off location on June 4 will be the **Media Center for students on campus** and the main entry to the school for students who have been learning virtually. Non 8th graders can also drop off their Chromebook, charger, and hot spot (if applicable) at the main entry of the school on June 4.
- Drop off location on June 7, 8, and 9 will be the Athletic Complex Entry (Gym Entry) by the bus parking lot.

Upon drop off, students will be provided a form to complete to place with their returned technology. The form will require the student's name, grade, valid phone number, and student ID number. (The [form](#) can also be completed and downloaded prior to the return of the technology provided.)

Please return all Chromebooks, Chargers, and Hot Spots in a clean condition.

The recommended cleaning is as follows:

- **Use a lint-free cloth, such as a screen wipe or a cloth made from microfiber.**
- **Avoid excessive wiping and submerging each item in cleanser to avoid damage.**
- **Do not use aerosol sprays, bleach, or abrasive cleaners.**
- **Ensure moisture does not get into any openings to avoid damage**
- **Never spray cleanser directly on an item**
