I agree to abide by the following rules and regulations. I further understand that by not complying with these rules, I risk having my parking privileges revoked and that no refund will be offered. Parking fees are **\$80.00**. Parking fees pay for security and are non-refundable. Lost hang tag replacement will cost \$10.00.

1. I must hold a valid driver's license.
2. I must display my hang tag on my rear view mirror or my car may be booted and I will have to pay \$25.00 to have the boot removed.
3. I must park in my designated space or my car may be booted and I will have to pay \$25.00 to have the boot removed.
4. I am not allowed in the parking lot during class time or during lunch, except to leave if I have permission.
5. I understand that while my automobile is parked on HHS property it can be searched by administration or law enforcement officers at any time if there is a suspicion of a policy violation that requires that my car be searched.
6. I am aware that unsafe driving of any kind, to be determined by school resource officers or administration, may result in revocation of my permit.
7. I understand that mechanical problems with my vehicle that result in tardiness or absence are not excused. Excessive attendance problems may result in revocation of my parking privileges.
8. I understand that neither DPS nor HHS is responsible for any stolen or damaged property while on school property.
9. I understand that my parking pass may not be used by any other student.

If I violate any of the driving rules or regulations, consequences may include, but are not limited to:

- 1st Offense: Warning
- 2nd Offense: An auto boot will be placed on vehicle and pay an immediate \$25.00 fine for removal
- 3rd Offense: An Auto book will be placed on vehicle and pay an immediate \$50.00 fine for removal
