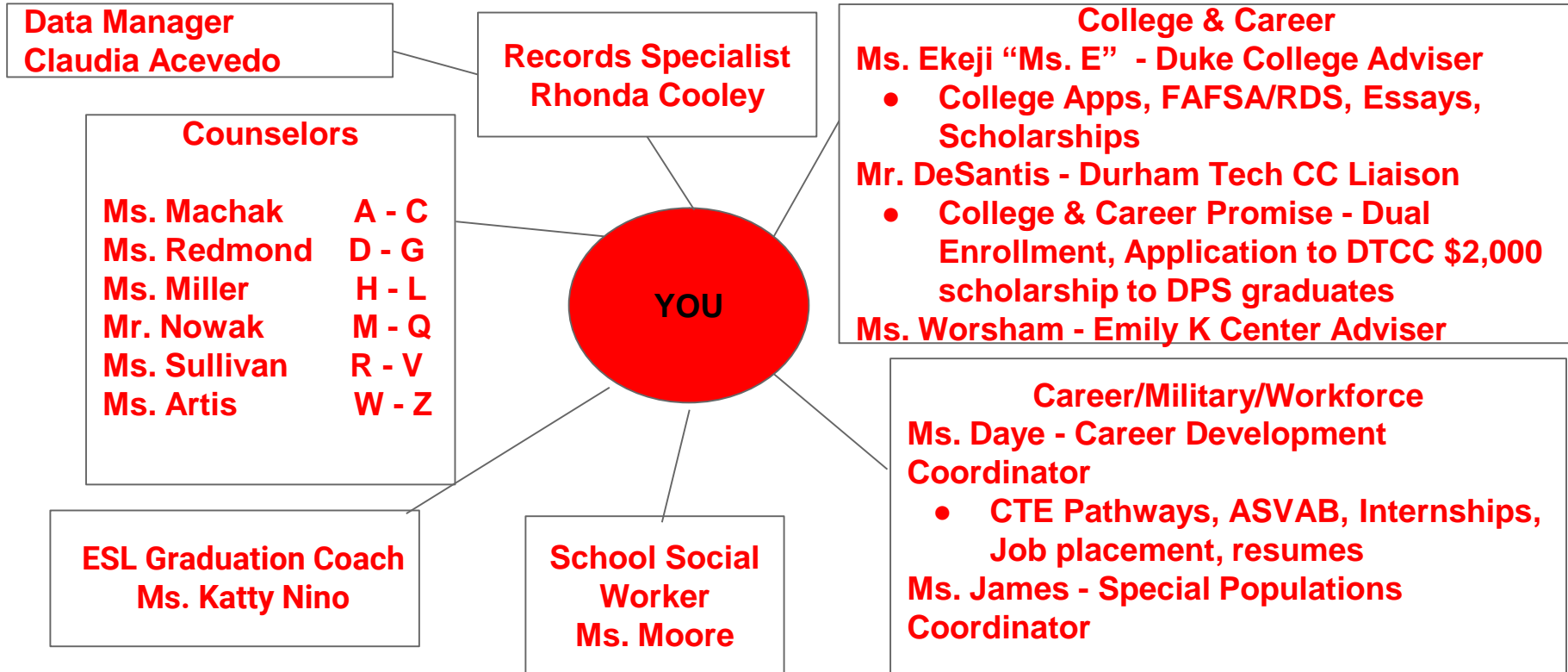

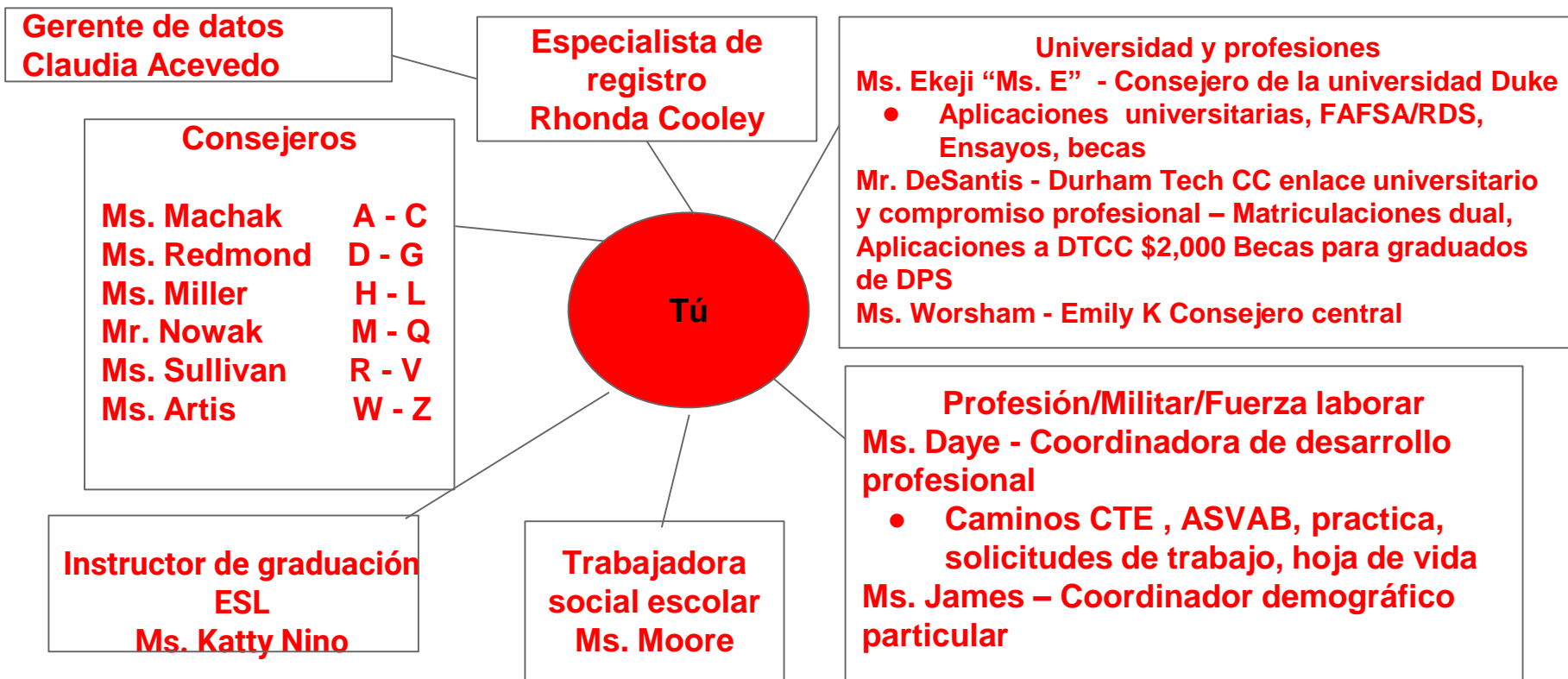

- 3** units of science including Biology and a Physical science
- 2** units of history



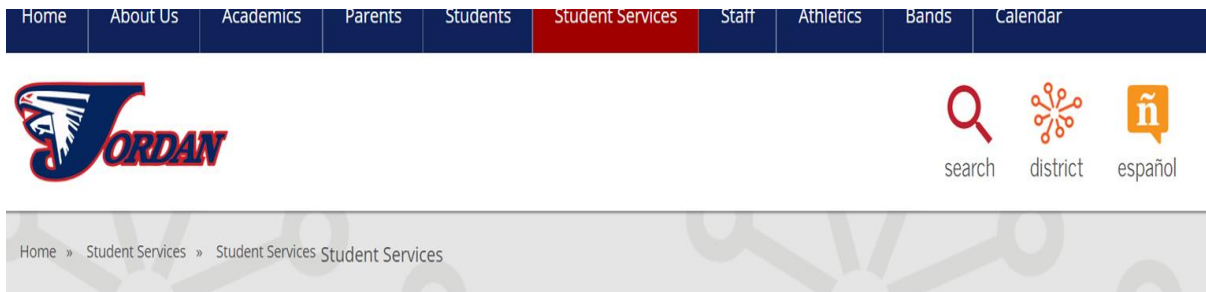
