Durham Public Schools uses the following grading scale:

A = 90 – 100 B = 80 – 89 C = 70 – 79 D = 60 – 69 F = 0 – 59

In previous years grade point averages were calculated on a graduated 7 point scale. In 2015, the state of North Carolina implemented the 10 point scale.

Grade point averages are computed at the end of each semester and incorporate all subjects. Class rank is determined on the basis of the weighted grade point average. A cumulative rank is reported to colleges and universities.
