My student tests positive... what do I do?

- Email Mike Mattia at michael_mattia@dpsnc.net with a copy of the test result
- Expect a phone call from the administrative team and be prepared to answer questions regarding:
 - Date of positive test
 - Siblings or additional children who live in your household and attend DPS schools
 - Your student's AM/PM transportation
 - Before/after school



COVID-19 Diagnosis or Close contact

- Students will need to quarantine for 10 days regardless of a positive test result or being deemed a close contact
 - If students are still showing symptoms after the 10 day period, they must stay home
 - They can only return after 24 hours of being symptom-free
- Asynchronous work will be provided through Canvas or Seesaw
- Teachers are available to students while they are quarantined
- Students absences due to quarantining will be excused



Siblings and Additional Children in Your Household Attending DPS schools

- If your student tests positive for COVID-19, siblings will need to quarantine for 10 days
- If your student is identified as a close contact at school, siblings do not need to quarantine
- Quarantine may be extended, if your student tests positive during quarantine
