Dear Parent/Guardian of EOC Students,

Durham Public Schools (DPS) is committed to providing all students with an excellent education. Your child will participate in the regular administration of the North Carolina End-of-Course (EOC) test in early June. Students who score Level 3 or higher on the EOC assessments are considered proficient.

While we will continue to provide your child with the daily instruction needed to reach proficiency on the EOC assessments, we want to make you aware of another opportunity for your child to demonstrate proficiency at the end of the school year.

The Take Two Summer Program is an opportunity to re-administer the North Carolina EOC assessments for Math 1, English II, Math 3, or Biology.

Students are identified as candidates for this opportunity based on their performance on the EOCs at the end of each semester. Candidates will receive additional instruction following the completion of the initial assessments. Then they will return to their home school after the end of the school year for an additional day of instruction. After the day of instruction, students will re-take one or more EOCs. Transportation and lunch will be provided.
