### **JHS PSAT Information 2023-24**

**PSAT REGISTRATION DEADLINE:** September 15th, 2023 at 5 p.m.

**PSAT DATE:** Wednesday, October 11, 2023

**PSAT LOCATION:** Jordan High School

**\* Identified Juniors do not have to complete the registration form—see criteria under “Who Can Take The PSAT.”\***

**WHAT IS THE PSAT:** The PSAT is a standardized, multiple-choice test that includes three sections: critical reading, mathematics, and writing. The test provides practice for the SAT and offers insight for advising and counseling students.

**WHO CAN TAKE THE PSAT:** The PSAT allows 11th grade students the opportunity to potentially qualify for a National Merit scholarship if they receive a very high score (generally the top 1%). For this reason, DPS is offering the test free of charge to those students in the top 10% of the junior class. JHS juniors who meet the criteria have already been notified, and automatically registered for the PSAT. All 11<sup>th</sup> grade students may register to take the PSAT for a fee of \$18. There are limited seats so register early! It is strongly recommended that students have earned a credit for Math I prior to taking the PSAT.

**HOW TO REGISTER:** Interested Jordan students who are **not** in the top 10% of the junior class should complete the [JHS PSAT Registration Form](#) and submit payment via the [Online Payment Portal](#) by **Friday September 15th, at 5 p.m.** (also found under “Quick Links” on the Jordan website). A limited number of fee waivers are also available for students based on financial need. Please contact your school counselor to discuss fee waivers.

**NOTE REGARDING ACCOMMODATIONS:** Juniors in the top 10% of the Junior class will receive accommodations **only** if they have applied for, or already have approved, accommodations through [College Board](#). All other students who register to take the PSAT will **only** receive accommodations if they have already submitted or approved accommodations through College Board. Neither JHS or DPS is responsible for approving accommodation requests.
