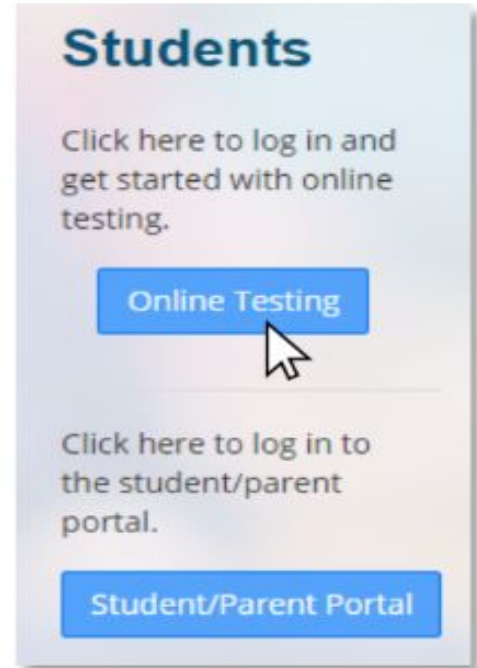

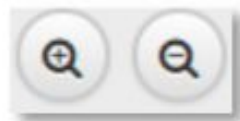

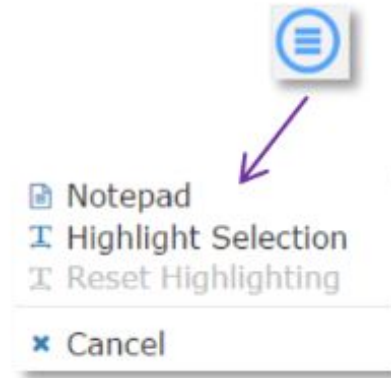

Notepad: Adds a notepad to the current question.

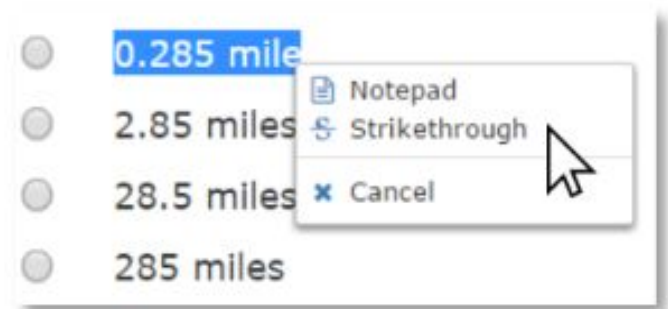
Highlight Selection: Select text and choose this option to highlight your selection.

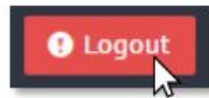

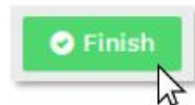


This button only appears on pages with multiple questions. Your answers are automatically saved every time you click **Next**.


