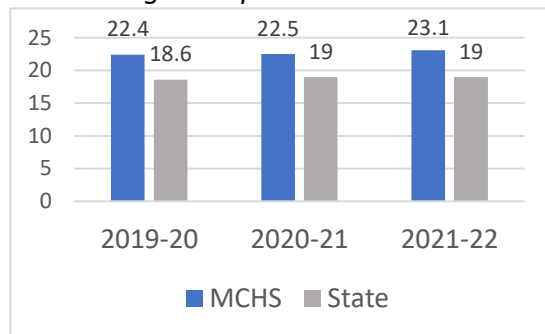
COVID Grading Spring 2020
