To enhance time management skills in order to improve academic achievement of all students

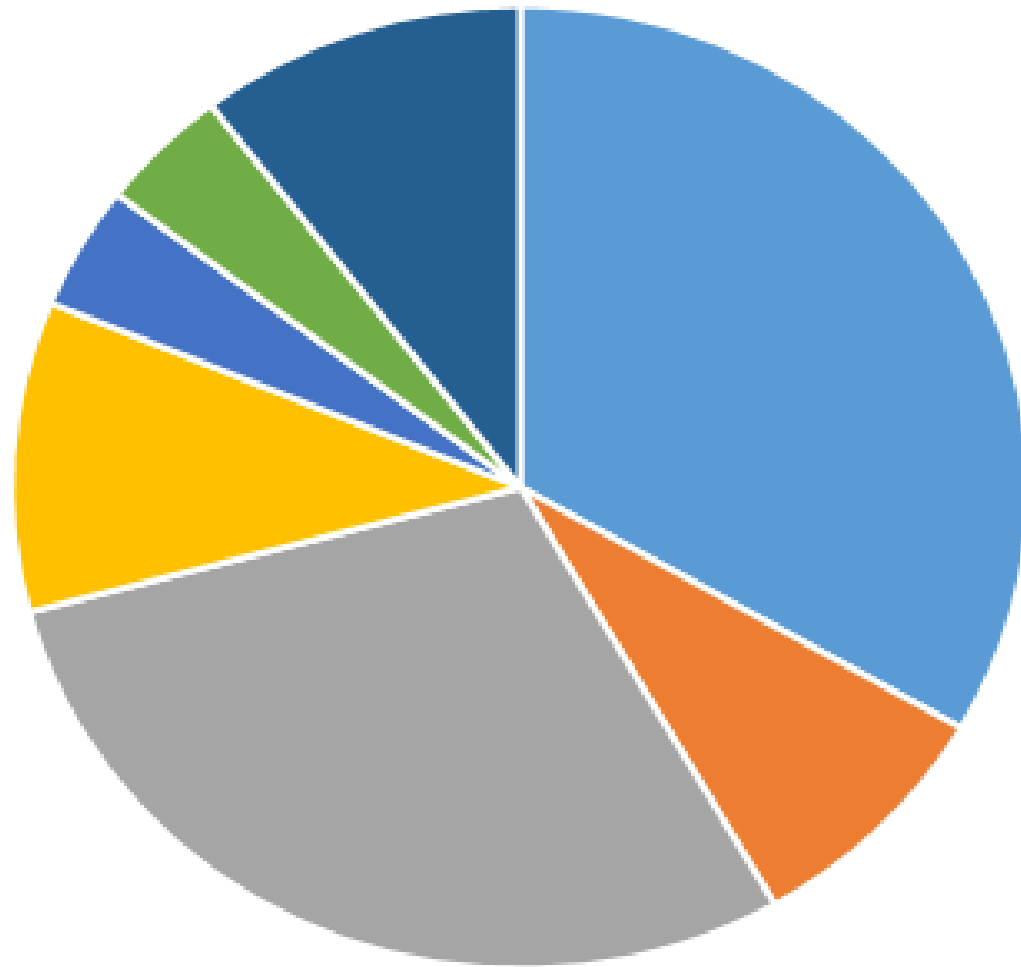

TRANSCRIPTS AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS



CLASS RANK AND GPA

GPA and class rank are established at the end of each semester. Final rank includes all courses attempted in high school (classes taken at NT and DTCC)

A (90-100) = 4 quality points

B (80-89) = 3 quality points

C (70-79) = 2 quality points

D (60-69) = 1 quality points

F (< 60) = 0 quality points

- Honor courses have a .5 weight added
- AP and DTCC courses have 1 weight added

GPA in PowerSchool only records the current quarter GPA. This GPA will change as teachers continue to input grades. You should always refer to your GPA on your transcript.
