Behavior Goal

During the 2017-2018 school year, Glenn Elementary School will have a 5% decrease in office referrals from the first semester to the second semester.

Academic Goals

- By the end of 2018 school year, 50% of the students at Glenn Elementary School in Grades 3-5 will meet grade proficiency as evidenced by the NC End of Grade Reading, Math and Science performance composite score.
- In grades K-2, 80% of the students will meet or exceed the mClass benchmarks for DIBELS, and 80% of students K-3 will meet or exceed mClass benchmarks for TRC.
- Glenn Elementary will exceed expected growth for the 2017-2018 school year.

Notes:
