* Qualifying Math 6 students will also have to demonstrate mastery of select Math 7 standards. Qualifying Math 7 students will also have to demonstrate mastery of select Math 8 standards.

** This course is a High School level class. With successful completion, HS credit will be earned. 8th graders enrolled in Common Core Math 1 will take BOTH the Math 8 EOG and the CC Math 1 EOC at the end of the year.
