

SOUTHWEST ELEMENTARY MASTER SCHEDULE for ONLINE LEARNING

REVISED FOR QUARTER 2

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS: Student hours will be from 8:00am - 3:00pm with 45 minute blocks and 15 minute breaks inbetween. Students will also have 1 hour for lunch each day.

PREPARATION: An asynchronous time for students and staff to prepare for instruction. All students should be logged in and ready at 8:15am.

MORNING MEETING: Morning Meeting time will need to include the teacher's greeting, attendance, and Move This World (5-10 minutes).

SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION: Students either work asynchronously on independent work or meet in a scheduled small group with either the classroom teacher, IA or a teacher for intervention, enrichment, EC, or ESL.

INTERVENTION/STUDENT CHECK IN: Students either work asynchronously on independent work or meet at a scheduled time with a teacher for intervention or a student check in.

options, school clubs, choice boards, or self-directed activities. Students needing to catch up on asynchronous work may also do so at this time.

SPECIALS: Specials will be held 3 days per week on an alternating A and B schedule with asynchronous choices available to families (The Specials' schedule can be accessed on our website)

DEAR TIME FRIDAYS: Every Friday students and families are encouraged to utilize the Specials' Block to Drop Everything And Read (DEAR Time).

INTERVENTION/CHOICE OPTIONS: Specials, support & resource teachers may be scheduled to support small groups, intervention/enrichment, or choice options when time allows.

ASYNCHRONOUS: When not assigned to a small group for guided instruction or intervention, students may be assigned asynchronous activities to complete independently. This can include i-Ready lessons which are matched to a student's ability. DPS expects all students to complete at least 30-45 minutes of math and 30-45 minutes of reading each week in i-Ready.
